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Introduction

On March 11th, Facebook has announced that it is going to change the way you build a fan page from FBML to using iframe. Now, if you don't understand what iframe is, I am going to talk about it just right now.

Iframe is a HTML tag that allows you to load another website in another website. Frankly speaking, iframe allows your website to display another website, like Google.com, for example.

So, why I say this will open endless opportunity for your businesses and services on Facebook?

You probably remember about the hardness when you need to deal with FBML, right? Well, you don't have to worry about it anymore with iframe. It's because you just need to develop a normal website and iframe will make your website display in Facebook fan page for you.

So, just take a look at the old Facebook fan page.

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Join Social Media SEO on Facebook

Welcome to Social Media SEO on Facebook - a place for technology news, tips, and information about Facebook, blogging, SEO, and social media. Here's what to do next:

1. Click the **"Become a Fan"** button above to join the community (Can't see a button? You're already a member!)
2. Head over to the [Social Media SEO wall](#) to join in the conversation!

You see, creating a fan page like this with FBML really takes much of your time. You need to insert HTML code and then test, test your fan page again until it reaches your desire design.

Fanpage Iframe Domination makes it easy. It's a Wordpress theme, means that you don't have to know any HTML to set up a website or so. All you need to do is create a Wordpress blog, install Fanpage Iframe Domination and voila, your fan page is done!

Following the steps I have listed below to see how you can turn a Wordpress blog into a Fanpage in 5 minutes...Guaranteed!

Step 1 - Install FID Theme to Your Blog

- The first step that you'll need to do is download the theme from the download area. It's also included in the email sent to you when you pay for the theme.
- Once you have downloaded, you'll see a zip file in your download folder

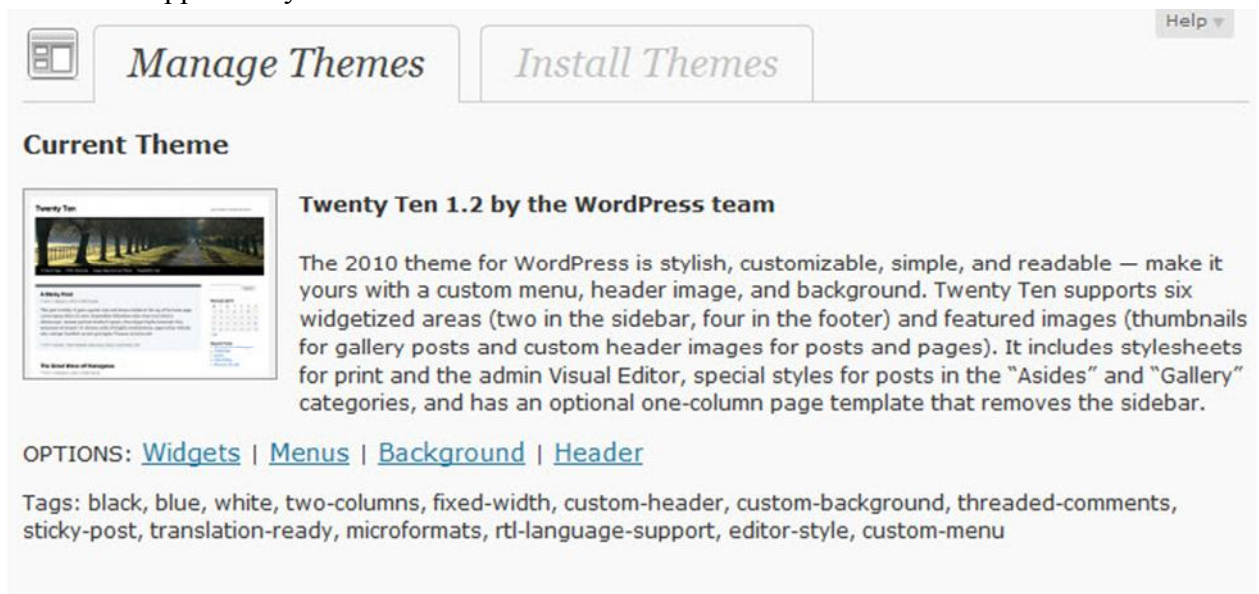


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- Log into your Wordpress admin dashboard

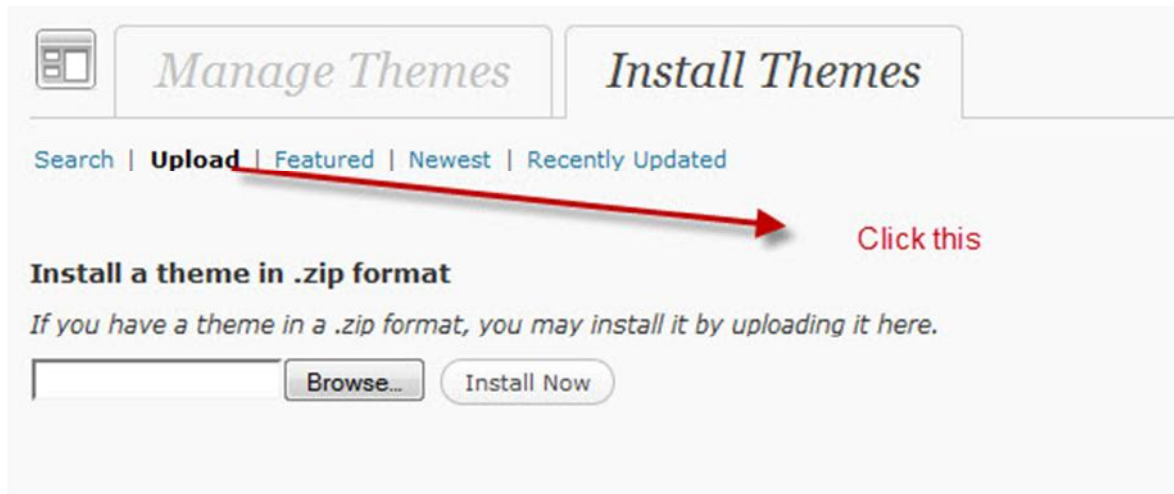


- Look on the left menu, find **Appearance** accordion and click on **Themes**. A following screen will appear on your screen.

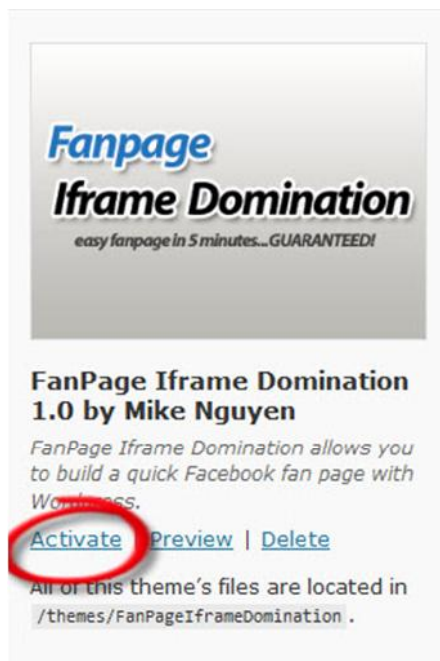


- Click on the **Install Themes** tab, and then, click on **Upload** link.

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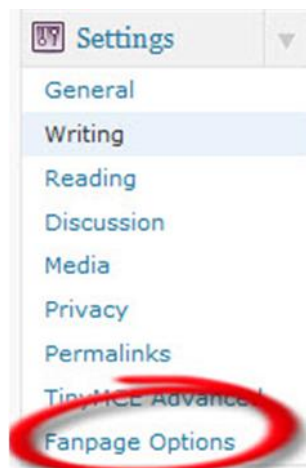
- Click on **Browse** and point to the theme which you have downloaded. After that, click on Install Now button.
- You'll be redirected to the Manage Themes screen. At this point, you will see my theme inactivated. Click on the Active button to activate this theme.



- At this point, congratulations! You have installed Fanpage Iframe Domination successfully!

Step 2 - Theme Settings

Once you have installed the theme, navigate to the **Settings** panel in your blog and click on **FanPage Options**



You will be redirected to admin panel of Fanpage Iframe Domination. The admin panel looks exactly below:

Fanpage Iframe Domination

I will explain what each option means:

1. **Header Image** – Uploads your header image here.
2. **Nav Bar Text Color** – Text color in your menu bar.
3. **Nav Bar Text Color (Shadow)** – Utilizes the power of CSS 3 to create beautiful text color. This option allows you to set the shadow color of your menu items.
4. **Nav Bar Text Hover Color** – Text color when users move over their mouse (but not click yet) on the menu item.
5. **Nav Bar Sub-Menu Text Color** – Fanpage Iframe Domination supports 2-level menu depth. This option sets the color for the text in sub menus.
6. **Nav Bar Sub-Menu Text Color (Shadow)** – The shadow color of text in sub-menus.
7. **Main Nav Bar Background** – The color of menu bar in your fan page. Fanpage Iframe Domination allows you to set the gradient color right in the admin panel. Select your desired top color and bottom color and the theme will mix them nicely for you.
8. **Sub Menu Background** – Sets the gradient color for the sub-menus.
9. **All Menus Background (Hover)** – Sets the gradient color for all of the menu when a user mouse over (hover) a menu item.
10. **Footer Background** – Sets the color for the footer area.
11. **Footer Text Color** – Sets the color for the footer text.
12. **Nav Bar Bottom Line Color** – Sets the color for the divider between menu and main content.
13. **Nav Bar Font-size** – Sets the font size for menu item.
14. **Nav Bar Bottom Line Thickness** – Sets the thickness of the divider.
15. **Body Font Style** – Sets the font, font size and color of the text in the main content.
16. **H2 Font Style** – Sets the font, font size and color of the header h2 tag.
17. **H3 Font Style** – Sets the font, font size and color of the header h3 tag.
18. **<a> Tag Font Style** – Sets the font, font-size and color of links.
19. **Footer Content** – Your credit, footer content (HTML) can be inserted in here.

After you have done uploading your header image and set the overall color of all elements, it's time to create a new fan page in your Facebook account. But at first, you must create a Facebook app.

Step 3 - Create Your Fan Page

Now that you have created your Wordpress site, the next step is create a fan page.

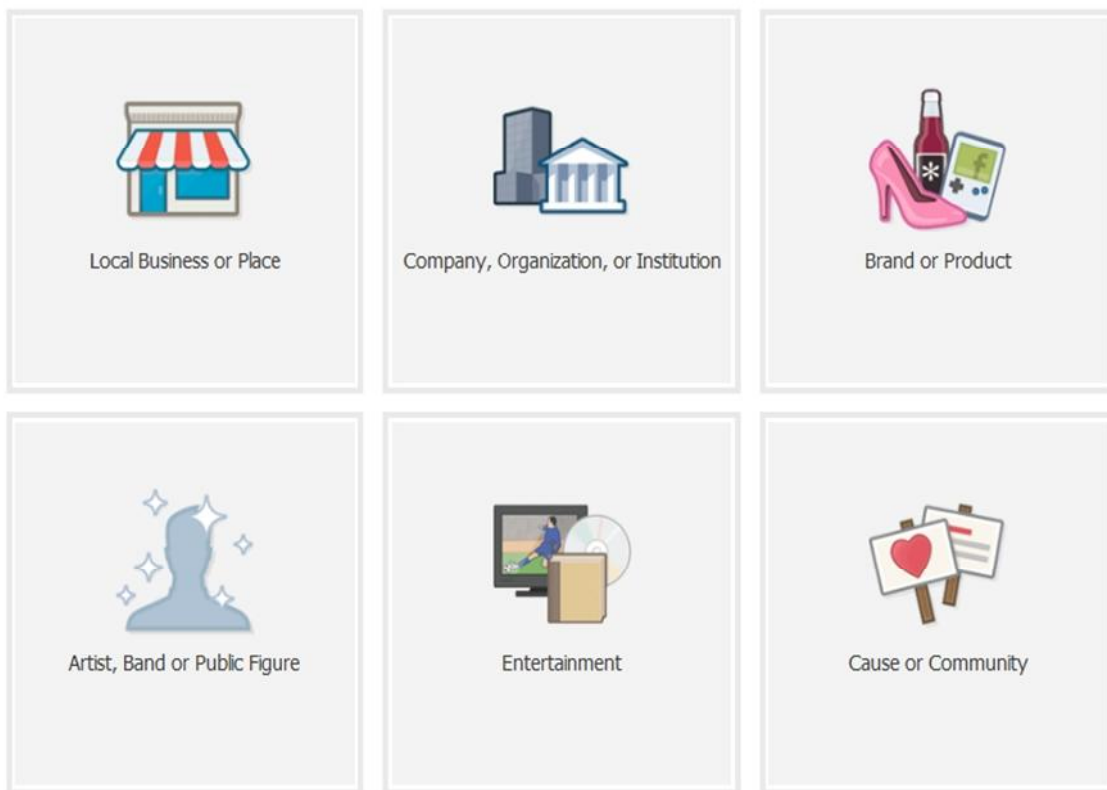
Go to <http://facebook.com>, and on the home page, right below the sign up boxes, you will see the link to create a Facebook page.

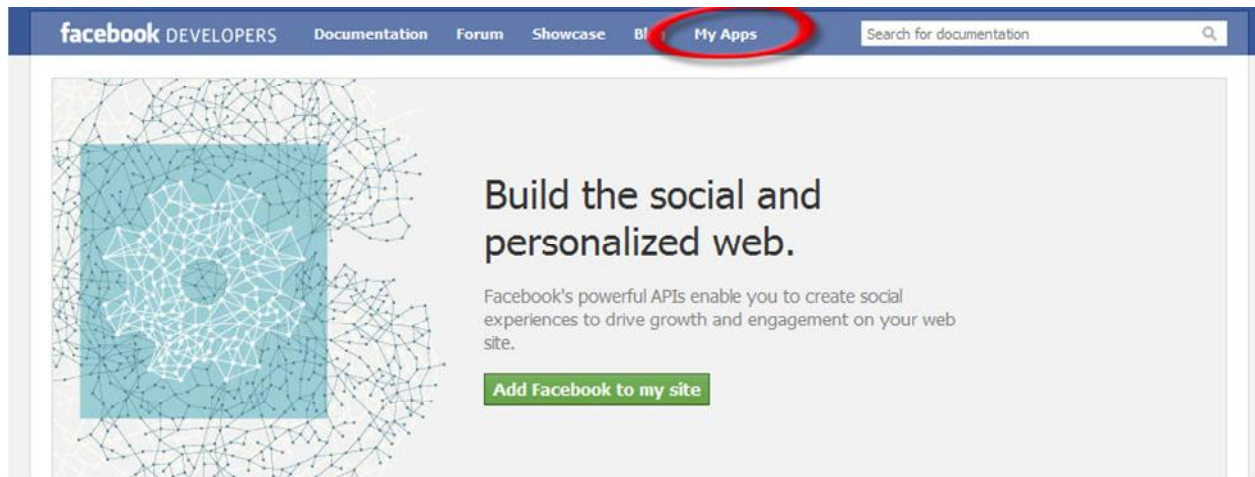

Step 4 - Create An Application

Now that I have my fanpage created, I also have the Wordpress minisite set up, the only thing left is to add the application to the fan page and I should be all set.

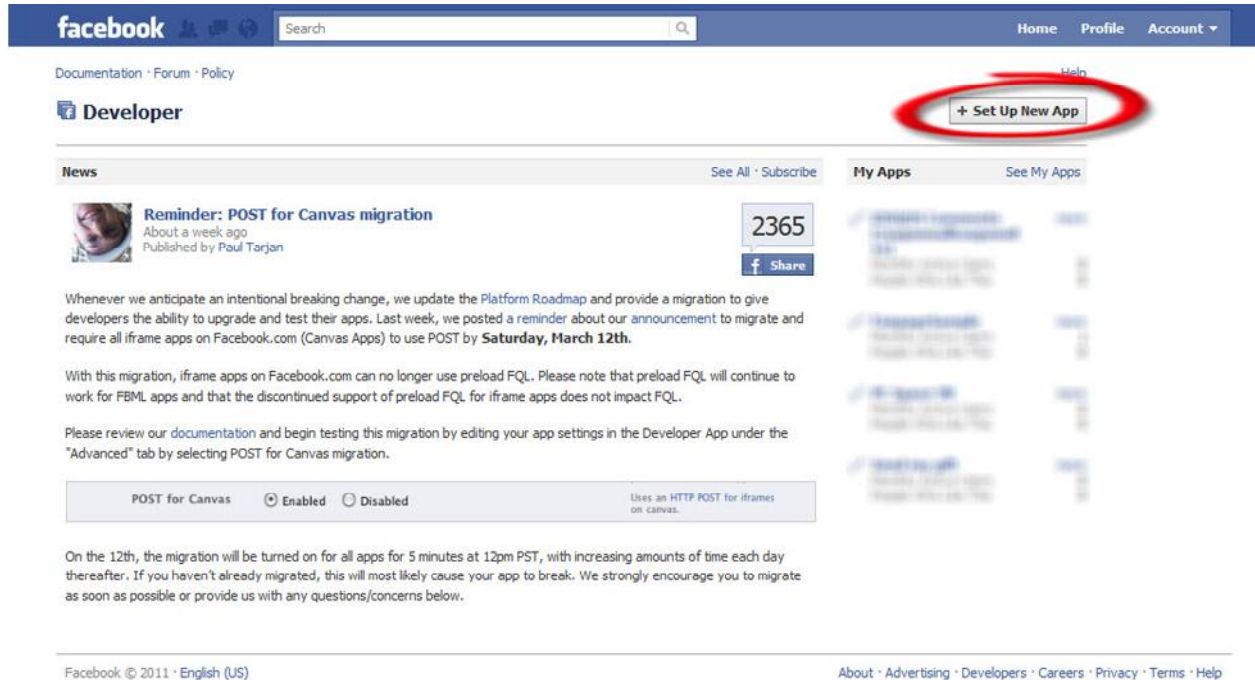
To create an application, you will need to go to <http://developers.facebook.com>

Click on My Apps link



After that, you should reach a place that looks like this:

At this screen, you are going to enter your Wordpress minisite URL in the **Site URL** textbox and the domain in the **Site Domain** textbox.

Please note that this is the major difference between the new iframe and the old FBML language. With new iframe, you are hosting content at your own server. Facebook no longer saves your code at its server.

So, at the screen above, I have entered my Wordpress minisite fanpage URL and the domain name. That should be it for now.

Click on the tab **Facebook Integration**, which opens the following screen:

For the Iframe size, please choose Auto-resize. Fanpage Iframe Domination comes automatically with the ability to resize itself to fit with your fan page area so you don't have to worry about scrolling.

In the Page Tabs section, type the tab name that you want to add to your fan page in the Tab Name textbox and choose Iframe in the Page Tab Type again.

Once you're done, click **Save changes**.

Step 5 - Add Your App to Your Fan page

Once you click **Save changes** in the step 4, you will be redirected to a screen that looks like this:

Changes saved. Note that your changes may take several minutes to propagate to all servers.

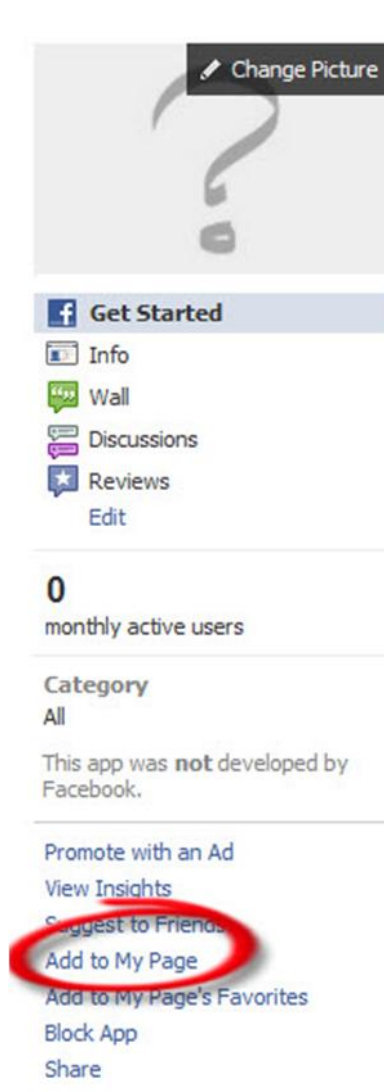

On your Application Profile page, click on **Add to My Page**

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Select the page you want to add to in the pop-up box.

At this step, you're completely done. Go to your fan page to see the newly added section with your fan page.
